Scholarship committee decisions will be based solely on the information provided by the applicant. The C.G.R.A. Scholarship committee decision is twofold:

1) How many scholarships will be awarded.

2) The dollar amount of the scholarship:

The financing for scholarships is determined by the percentage of funds accumulated by means of casino and bingo revenue in the previous year. Any member in good standing may apply for a scholarship provided they meet the criteria listed below. The scholarship can be applied toward a college/trade or post secondary educational institution, online and correspondence courses.

1) ONE CURRENT SEALED LETTER OF REFERENCE:

Must state:

- Length of time known by the author.
- Applicants work habits, personality, goals/ambitions, and contributions to society in general
Reference should not be relatives.

2) LETTER BY THE APPLICANT:

Must address the following:

- Benefits that scholarship funds would give the applicant in furthering their goals and ambitions.
- Involvement in C.G.R.A., what you as a member have contributed to the betterment of the Association.
- Involvement in your local community to include such things as volunteer services and any participation in community groups.
- The subject or course they are studying, what school they are attending or planning to attend.
- Has the applicant received a scholarship in previous years and if so how have they progressed?

3) CURRENT LETTER OF REFERENCE FROM ONE CURRENT OR PAST DIRECTOR WHO IS ACTIVELY COMPETING IN C.G.R.A. RODEOS:

- Letter from Directors must be sent separate and to CGRA Scholarship email account ONLY:

- Recipient will be notified by scholarship committee via email once this letter has been received.

Must state:

- Length of time known by the author.
- What the applicant has contributed to the Association.
References should not be relatives.

The applicant must be compliant with the following C.G.R.A. rules:

- 1) A scholarship applicant is required to have completed a membership for 2 consecutive years and hold a current card. (Minimum third year as a member of the CGRA)
- 2) In order to qualify for a scholarship and receive funding, you must work your regular bingos in the year you apply or equivalent and attend 4 rodeos in the current season.
